

As of the end of October, actual net income of \$67,757 was significantly better than budget. The three main driving factors are:

- -- Lower staff salaries \$18,038
- -- Recovery of stolen funds \$53,636
- -- Higher than expected weekly offerings \$12,330

#### Hello from Property

The end of 2022 is upon us as we begin to celebrate the season of Advent. Your church property continues to look very good. Our Property Group and volunteers continue to find ways to enhance the beauty of our church, fellowship hall and grounds which are in our care. We are currently decorating the church and fellowship hall for Christmas. I guess you could say we are all good stewards of what we have been given. Thank you all for your support in making our campus extra special.

We are currently awaiting the installation of our new air conditioning system by GATER Air and Heat in our fellowship hall. One half of our system is being replaced as it stopped working several months ago and our fellowship hall basically requires two large systems to keep it cool. We are currently cleaning our church steeple on the exterior. At some point in 2023 we will be inspecting and cleaning the ceiling inside of our church to remove soiled areas and cobwebs. A new water spigot has been installed outside of our fellowship hall and a lock placed on it to prevent use by non-members. The main water supply valve to the church and fellowship hall has been freed up in the event of an emergency. Over time the valve had seized up.
